

Recognizing Domestic Violence

It isn't always physical.









Abuse can be verbal, emotional, financial, sexual or spiritual.

Domestic violence is a pattern of violent behavior that one person uses to exert power and control over another.

Self-defense is NOT domestic violence.

Remember: change takes time, everyone's journey is unique and she is the expert on her own safety!

Warning Signs

- Her abuser seems to have the final say in every decision and she appears reluctant or fearful to give an answer.
- You realize she does not have any access to her owr
- ! She appears fearful of any sort of confrontation.
- She tends to minimize words or behaviors in the relationship that seem inappropriate or abusive to you.
